2021 Colorado Diversity Scholarship Application

- Copy of most recent FAFSA SAR (if older than 2 years, also provide a copy of your most recent tax return)
- Letter of recommendation from a law school professor or employer
- An essay of 250 words or less answering: What do you plan to do once you are licensed as an attorney?
- An essay of 250 words or less answering: Why should you be selected for the scholarship(s)?
- An essay of 250 words or less answering: How will your background enrich and promote diversity and inclusiveness in the legal profession?
