Black History Month?

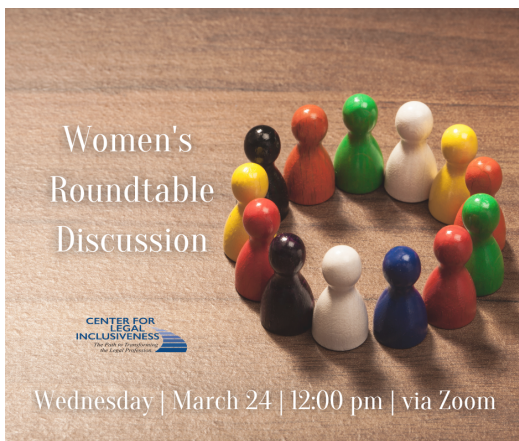
Or what did you intend to do and never

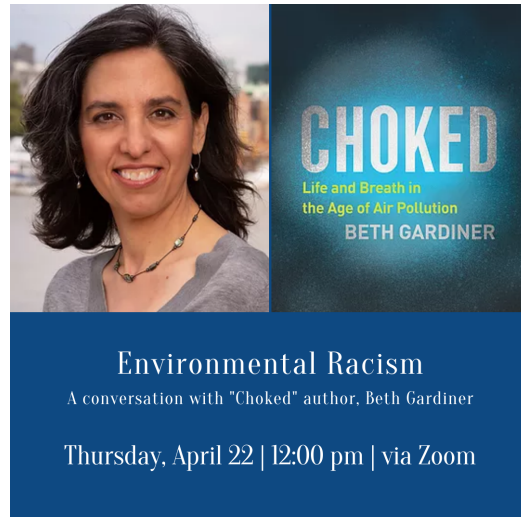

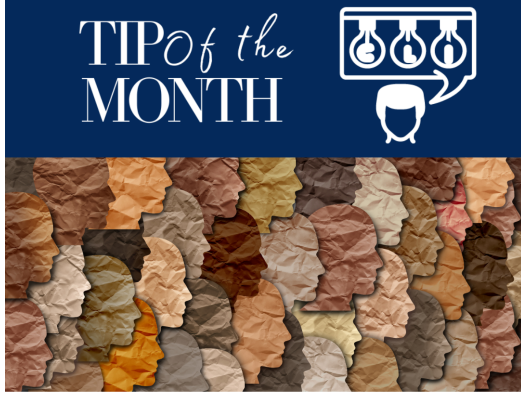
